Requirements:

- All written public education (PE) materials must be submitted to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), Bureau of Safe Drinking Water (BSDW) for review and approval **prior** to distribution/issuance (40 C.F.R. 141.85(a)(1)). Recommend providing the BSDW with at least 14 calendar days for review and revisions.
- Complete the PE requirements pursuant to NJ S968 within 10 calendar days after the water system confirms that there has been a lead action level exceedance (ALE) with the BSDW.
- Complete the remainder of the PE requirements as soon as possible but no later than 60 days after the end of the monitoring period in which the lead ALE occurred. Refer to Table 1 below to find your water system’s issuance due date.

Instructions:

- If you indicated Community Water System (CWS) above, complete Sections: 1, 2, and 4, as applicable.
 - If written approval from BSDW was received to conduct PE in accordance with 40 CFR 141.85(b)(7), complete Sections: 1.A – 1.B, 3, and 4, as applicable.
- If you indicated Non-Transient, Transient, or Non-Public Water System (NTNCWS, TNCWS, or NP) above, complete Sections: 1.A – 1.B, 3, and 4, as applicable.
 - A NTNCWS, TNCWS, or NP Water System may also satisfy the requirements of the Lead Consumer Notice as long as the PE contains all the sample locations and results.
