



## 2019-2020 HARDING TOWNSHIP SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

### KINDERGARTEN

- Back pack
- 1 empty pencil case (no pencil boxes please - Supplies will be provided in school)
- Smock or old t-shirt for art
- Beach towel or large towel for rest

### FIRST GRADE

- 1 pencil case
- 1 box (12) Ticonderoga pre-sharpened pencils
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 3 erasers
- 5 glue sticks
- 1 large box tissues
- Smock or old t-shirt for art
- 1 package of 3x3 post-it notes
- Earbuds/Headphones to keep in the classroom

### SECOND GRADE

- 3 boxes (12) Ticonderoga pre-sharpened pencils
- 1 box of 12 crayons
- 1 pack of 12 markers
- 5 large erasers
- 5 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 3 highlighters
- 2 packages of 3in. x 3in. post-it notes
- pencil pouch
- 1 package of Lysol wipes
- Earbuds/Headphones to keep in the classroom

### THIRD GRADE

- Headphones or earbuds to keep in the classroom
- 1 8.5 x 11 special writing notebook

- 1 pack of 12 crayons
- 2 boxes (12) Ticonderoga pre-sharpened pencils
- 3 packs of 3in x3in Post- It Notes (not the pop-up type).
- 1 package of Lysol wipes
- Smock or old t-shirt for art
- 1 pack of black dry erase markers

*Please be sure your child practices his/her math facts: addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.*

### FOURTH GRADE

- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 pack of dry erase markers
- Ruler
- 1-journal for writing (8 ½ x 11 notebook)
- A baby picture in a sealed envelope with name
- 1 pencil bag
- One 3 subject notebook
- 1 plastic folder for homework
- 2 boxes of sharpened pencils
- 1 pair of headphones/earbuds to be left at school

### FIFTH GRADE \*

- 2 combination locks (hallway & gym lockers) **please, no fancy oversized locks - they do not fit the lockers**
- 1 pencil case

### BAND - REQUIRED FOR ALL BAND STUDENTS IN GRADES 4-8

- one 1½ inch binder or folder
