Acute toxicity: Relatively nontoxic after single ingestion. Relatively nontoxic after short-term skin contact. Relatively nontoxic after short-term inhalation. **Irritation / corrosion:** May cause moderate but temporary irritation to the eyes. May cause slight irritation to the skin. **Sensitization:** Skin sensitizing effects were not observed in animal studies.
